Marg's Further Update

Marg's last checkup just before we left for Florida went well and she is now down to having blood tests once a month rather than biweekly. So we will have it done down here in Florida. Praise the Lord that her health is improving. Having a good exercise program here (4 mornings a week) really helps with weight control and flexibility for both of us.

As you probably know by now, we officially retired from active, day to day ministry with Global Recordings Network after 26 years of service and 35 years as missionaries. We will continue to be very involved and engage any opportunities that come our way to share the gospel with both the USA and Canadian offices.

It took us a lot of time to get the trailer in Canada winterized and ready to face the cold Canadian winter while we are down south enjoying the warmth. We could start to feel the joints

and the arthritis pain as the weather was turning too cold and great to be back down in the heat where the joints don't bother us.

We left Canada on Oct 13th and arrived down here on the 15th. We had some fun on the trip as a large piece of metal fell off a pickup truck ahead of us and after ripping the brake lines off the transport in front of us, it destroyed the front and rear tires on the **driver's** side of the car. While we praise the Lord that the piece of metal did not come up through the windshield or mangle any parts of the front of the car, it did mean two tow trucks, a 5-hour delay and \$700.00 for two new tires, tow and labour charges. Otherwise it was a long and boring trip!

Further to the last one, I did have the joy of speaking at the Men's breakfast meeting at the Green Valley Alliance church on Oct 1st. We had good a show of men and I was able to share about GRN and our own personal testimony.

In September, we celebrated Marg's birthday and our grandson Marshall's birthday (11). We travelled to Holland, Michigan for the International Board meetings of Christian Mission Aid (CMA) where I serve on that board as well as the Canadian Board as Treasurer Following the meetings in Michigan, we had the Canadian Board meetings at Victory Baptist Church on Sept 14th. The following Sunday, I was able to share about CMA at Victory in place of our Kenya Board Chairman, Edwyn Kiptinness who had been injured in a car accident in Kenya and was not able to come to Canada.

We are getting back into the swing of things down here and back into the church that we attend. I am also getting ready for the Men's Bible study that I will lead shortly.
